Requirements for Advancement to State Referee 06 (S2)

In consultation with the State Referee Administrator, the State Director of Assessment and the State Director of Instruction, the following upgrade process has been established for all referees upgrading from grade 7 to grade 6. The USSF Criteria for Advancement from Grade 7 to Grade 6 is shown in the table below.

Criteria	State Referee Grade 6
Minimum age	18
Experience - minimum cumulative career affiliated outdoor games at designated level	Referee: 100 (U-18 Affiliated Competitive Leagues, or higher) Assistant Referee: 25
Game level to be counted for advancement	Under-18 Affiliated Competitive leagues or higher level or from the U.S. Soccer list of approved games.
Time in present grade	12 months as Referee Grade 7 prior to application
Training course requirements	19 hour State Referee Training Course
Written Examination	75% minimum score on U.S. Soccer State Referee Exam
Field Evaluation by currently registered U.S. Soccer Assessor*	Pass two field assessments as referee (one must be on Div. 2 adult or higher) and one as assistant referee in Under-19 competitive league or higher or from the U.S. Soccer list of approved games..
Physical Fitness Test	Required (with passing score- see page 25)

Written Notice of Intent to Upgrade

A notice of intent to upgrade must be made in writing to the State Referee Administrator. You must include your Referee Match Log detailing the minimum of 100 games as a Referee, U-18 Affiliated Competitive Leagues or higher, and a minimum of 25 games as an Assistant Referee. The State Referee Administrator will review your Referee Match Log and make sure you have had at least 12 months as a grade 7 referee.

Your game log should include for each match, at a minimum, the following elements ([Download Match Game Log](#) (MS Excel)):

- Match date
- Location
- Level of Competition
- Score
- Home Team
- Visiting Team
- Level of Competition
- Names of other Referees on the Officiating Crew

19 – Hour Training Course and Written Examination

Once your game log and your 12 months as a grade 7 referee have been verified, your name will be given to the State Director of Instruction. You must have completed the 19-hour State Referee Training Course. You must take a State Referee written exam and pass with a minimum score of 75%. A Physical Fitness Test is required (with passing score- see page 26 of the Administrative Handbook for details or on the COREferees.org website: [Fitness Testing](#) page.

Upgrade Assessment

Upon completion of the clinic, written and physical fitness tests, your name will be passed on to the State Director of Assessment for scheduling of your upgrade assessments. You must pass 2 field assessments as a Referee. One must be on a Div 2 or higher adult match using the DSC. You must pass an assessment as an Assistant Referee in a U19 or higher competitive league or higher or from the U.S. Soccer list of approved games. A \$165.00 check must be sent to the State Referee Administrators office before your assessment can be scheduled. The address for the State Referee Administrator is:
