### Colorado Referee Recertification for 2009

If you have not completed the Requirements for your Referee Grade you have 4 options to be certified for this year.

1. To maintain your present grade:
  - a. Complete the requirements for your grade as stated in the USSF Referee Administrative handbook, 2008 edition, by May 31, 2009.
    - i. Attend a USSF Recertification clinic and pass the written test.
    - ii. Pass the physical fitness test for your current age and grade. Check [coreferees.org](http://coreferees.org) website for a schedule of fitness tests.
    - iii. Pass a maintenance assessment (Grades 6 & 5). Contact the SDA or SRA to schedule an assessment.
  - b. Complete the online registration at [www.ussoccer.info/](http://www.ussoccer.info/) OR download and complete a registration form from [www.coreferees.org](http://www.coreferees.org) and bring it along with a check for the appropriate amount (\$55 for Grade 7, \$75 for Grades 6 & 5) to a Recertification clinic. Registration may also be mailed to the CJRC at the address above.
2. Be downgraded to Referee 1 (Grade 7):
  - a. Complete the requirements for this grade as stated in the USSF Referee Administrative handbook, 2008 edition, by May 1, 2009.
    - i. Attend a USSF Recertification clinic and pass the written test.
    - ii. Pass the physical fitness test for your current age and grade. Check [coreferees.org](http://coreferees.org) website for a schedule of fitness tests.
  - b. Complete the online registration at [www.ussoccer.info/](http://www.ussoccer.info/) OR download and complete a registration form from [www.coreferees.org](http://www.coreferees.org) and bring it along with a check for the appropriate amount (\$55 for Grade 7) to a Recertification clinic.
3. Be downgraded to Referee 2 (Grade 8):
  - a. Complete the requirements for this grade as stated in the USSF Referee Administrative handbook, 2008 edition, by May 1, 2009.
    - i. Attend a USSF Recertification clinic and pass the written test.
  - b. Complete the online registration at [www.ussoccer.info/](http://www.ussoccer.info/) OR download and complete a registration form from [www.coreferees.org](http://www.coreferees.org) and bring it along with a check for the appropriate amount (\$50 for Grade 8) to a Recertification clinic.
4. Petition for Emeritus status:
  - a. Have 3 years of registration as a State Referee (Grade 5 or 6)
  - b. Submit a personal letter stating your intent to the SRA
  - c. Complete the online registration at [www.ussoccer.info/](http://www.ussoccer.info/) OR download and complete a registration form from [www.coreferees.org](http://www.coreferees.org) and mail it along with a check for \$75 to SRA, PO Box 495, Wheat Ridge, CO 80034.
  - d. If, at any time, you decide to return to full grade status, you must complete the requirements for your previous grade and pay a \$25 processing fee.
